JOINT COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

Minutes of the Meeting under s. 13.10

June 15, 2023

Co-Chair Born presided and called the meeting to order.

Present: Representatives Born, Katsma, Rodriguez, Kurtz, Dallman, Goyke, McGuire

Senators Marklein, Stroebel, Felzkowski, Ballweg, Testin, Wimberger, Johnson, Roys

I. Department of Health Services

Moved by Representative Goyke and seconded by Representative McGuire to approve the department's plan for the expenditure of \$8 million in settlement funds for Wisconsin's share of funds to be received from proceedings under *In re: National Prescription Opiate Litigation, Case No: MDL 2804* as follows: 1) \$4,000,000 for Narcan and Fentanyl test strip distribution programs; 2) \$3,000,000 to allocate for creation of grants to fund capital projects for facilities used by substance use treatment providers; 3) \$1,000,000 to fund dissemination of K-12 substance use prevention curriculum.

Moved by Representative Born and seconded by Senator Marklein to approve Motion 110. The motion reads as follows: Move to approve the allocation of \$8 million in settlement funding that the state expects to receive in 2023 under settlement agreements involving three prescription opioid distributors (Cardinal, McKesson, and AmerisourceBergen) and one pharmaceutical manufacturer (Janssen Pharmaceuticals and its parent company, Johnson and Johnson), as follows:

- 1. Narcan and Fentanyl Test Strip Distribution. Allocate \$2.9 million for ongoing initiatives under the Narcan Direct and Fentanyl Test Strip direct programs, Narcan and fentanyl test strip distribution under the EMS Leave Behind Program, and law enforcement agency distribution.
- 2. Residential Use Disorder Treatment Room and Board Grants. Allocate \$2.5 million for grants to counties and tribes for room and board costs for individuals receiving residential substance use disorder treatment.

- 3. Medication Assisted Treatment. Allocate \$2.0 million for supporting the cost of medication assisted treatment for individuals with opioid use disorder.
- 4. Substance Use Disorder Treatment Platform. Allocate \$0.3 million to pay a vendor for collecting and maintaining information regarding substance use disorder treatment providers for the state's substance use disorder treatment platform.
- 5. Surgical Collaborative of Wisconsin. Allocate \$0.3 million to make a grant to the Surgical Collaborative of Wisconsin to provide training to Wisconsin surgeons on practices to prevent abuse of prescription opioids following surgery.

Note:

This motion would approve a plan to allocate \$8.0 million of opioid settlement payments that the state expects to receive in calendar year 2023 under agreements with three prescription distributors (Cardinal, McKesson, and AmerisourceBergen) and one pharmaceutical manufacturer (Janssen Pharmaceuticals and its parent company, Johnson and Johnson),
