The department would receive additional position authority, including for fiscal year 2023-24, the extension of 1.0 FTE PR project position in the department's appropriation under s. 20.165(1)(g) and 1.0 FTE PR project position in the department's appropriation under s. 20.165(1)(hg) for health care credentialing, and the creation of 0.25 FTE PR permanent position in the department's appropriation under s. 20.165(2)(kd) to support budget and finance activities; and, for fiscal year 2024-25, the creation of 5.0 FTE PR project positions for credentialing in the department's appropriation under s. 20.165(1)(hg). The department also would receive additional expenditure authority, including \$59,100 PR in fiscal year 2023-24 and \$211,100 PR in fiscal year 2024-25 in the department's appropriation under s. 20.165(1)(g); \$59,100 PR in fiscal year 2023-24 and \$932,200 PR in fiscal year 2024-25 in the department's appropriation under s. 20.165(1)(hg); and \$131,000 PR in fiscal year 2024-25 in the department's appropriation under s. 20.165(2)(j). The funding would support the positions and retention of the services of 21 contracted call center support staff.
