

# IPC Information

The Interagency Procurement Council (IPC) is tasked with identifying ways to further streamline and reform the state procurement process, while also making it more transparent and accountable. The IPC may recommend changes to current procurement policies and procedures.

The membership consists of representatives of state agencies with purchasing delegation. Those agencies are: Department of Children and Families, Department of Justice, Department of Corrections, Department of Health Services, Department of Workforce Development, Department of Transportation, Department of Natural Resources, University of Wisconsin System, and the UW Madison. The Department of Administration also has a seat on the council, representing it and the state agencies that do not have delegated purchasing authority.
