

State Capitol and Executive Residence Board

Purpose: The 16-member State Capitol and Executive Residence Board, created by chapter 183, Laws of 1967, includes 7 citizen members with specified expertise, appointed by the governor to serve staggered 6-year terms. The purpose of the State Capitol and Executive Residence Board is to direct the continuing and consistent maintenance of the property, decorative furniture and furnishings of the capitol and executive residence. No renovation, repairs except repairs of an emergency nature, installation of fixtures, decorative items or furnishing for the ground and buildings of the capitol or executive residence may be performed by or become the property of the state by purchase wholly or in part from state funds, or by gift, loan or otherwise until approved by the Board as to design, structure, composition and appropriateness.
