

I have 35-years of experience serving as a mediator in different settings. For 10-years, I served as a Mediator on the staff of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission (WERC). For the last 25-years, I have been in private practice as a mediator and arbitrator. At present, I mediate: as a participant in the Wisconsin Special Education Mediation System, between parents and school districts concerning educational issues over services made available to children with special needs; between the Archdiocese of Milwaukee and Victim/survivors of priest sexual abuse; employment and labor disputes, particularly in the public sector. As an arbitrator of public sector interest disputes, I decide issues over the amount and whether employees will receive pay increases, relative contribution levels toward health insurance, and other benefit and working condition issues.

I serve as a neighborhood representative to a Joint Committee of the University of Wisconsin and the City of Madison that addresses the development plans of the University and the impact it has on neighborhoods that abut the University.

On two occasions, I served as President of Beth Israel Center a synagogue in Madison and had to address the funding, personnel, neighborhood issues a religious institution with a facility must face.

I served as the Chair of the Labor and Employment Law Section of the State Bar of Wisconsin.


