11	Settlement Agreement Between the Village and Town of Pewaukee	V. Pewaukee, T. Pewaukee	Waukesha	1989	Resolves annexation litigation and establishes municipal sewer service to certain Town lands without requiring annexation.

Neenah	Winnebago	2003	Resolves annexation litigation, establishes future boundaries, and Village sewer service to certain Town lands without requiring annexation. Creates service sharing and coordination, and protects environmental resources.

Koshkonong	Jefferson	1999	Resolves annexation litigation, establishes future boundaries, and maintenance, access and jurisdiction of certain roads. Also contains provisions regarding City extraterritorial review, stormwater management, and preservation of wetlands.
14	Final Boundary Agreements Between the City of Green Bay and the Town of Scott	C. Green Bay, T. Scott	Brown	2003	Resolves litigation involving competing annexation and incorporation petitions, transfers territory from the Town to City, and City to Town, establishes future boundaries, Contains provisions regarding road maintenance, cooperative sewer and water service, City police and fire service to certain Town areas.
15	Intermunicipal Agreement between the City of Appleton and the Town of Grand Chute and its Sanitary Districts to Provide for Orderly Land Development and Sanitary Sewer Services with the Town of Grand Chute	C. Appleton, T. Grand Chute	Outagamie	1992	Agreement squaring off irregular boundaries, creating City and Town growth areas, providing for orderly land development and establishing coordinated sanitary sewer service.

Campbell	La Crosse	2004	Resolves litigation regarding the Town's incorporation petitions, establishes a long-term boundary, transfers territory from the Town to City, assures orderly development, and allows the Town to maintain 4 square miles of territory.

Lawrence	Brown	2004	Resolves annexation litigation, creates City growth area, provides for transfer of conservancy areas between the City and Town, and coordinates sewer service.

Cottage Grove, T. Cottage Grove	Dane	1996	Resolves annexation litigation, creates a Village Growth Area inside which the Town may not contest annexations, and outside of which Town consent of annexations is required, based on certain standards. Also commits the communities to developing a cooperative boundary plan, and creates a 'boundary committee'.
19	Boundary Stipulation and Revenue Sharing Agreement between the Town of Hartford and the Village of Slinger**	V. Slinger, T. Hartford	Washington	2003	Resolves annexation litigation, commits the communities to develop a long term boundary agreement, and requires the Village to share property tax revenue with the Town.
20	Intermunicipal Agreement Between the City of Menasha and Town of Menasha	C. Menasha, T. Menasha	Winnebago	1998	Resolves annexation litigation, establishes fixed boundaries, establishes a Town Utility District, permits Town residents to use a City pool.

Cottage Grove	Dane	2001	Resolves litigation stemming from disagreement whether an annexation violated the terms of the communities' 1996 agreement. Amendment clarifies when annexations may occur outside the Village Growth Area, and replaces the boundary committee with a 'Joint Planning Committee'.
