TITLE: MAXIMUM CDBG-ED and PFED GRANT AWARD AMOUNTS

EFFECTIVE DATE: July 1, 2013,
Updated May 18, 2015

OVERVIEW

Description

This policy references the maximum funding limits for Community Development Block Grants for Economic Development (CDBG-ED) and projects granted after July 1, 2013.

Purpose

The Administrative Rules in place for the former Department of Commerce, Comm108 set the maximum amount of a CDBG-ED award of \$1 million in a program year. On July 1, 2011, the former Department of Commerce was abolished as were the rules promulgated in Comm108. Also on July 1, 2011, the CDBG program was transferred to the Department of Administration – Division of Housing (DOH). At that time the DOH entered into an agreement with the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC) to perform certain administrative tasks related to CDBG-ED, CDBG Public Facilities (CDBG-PF), CDBG Public Facilities for Economic Development (CDBG-PFED), and CDBG Planning. On July 1, 2013, the DOH transferred all CDBG administrative duties to the DOH. The DOH promulgated Emergency Rules to replace the abolished Comm108. The Emergency rule EmR1309 was effective on July 1, 2013. The formal Administrative Rule, Adm 93 was effective May 1, 2014 and is found at:

Policy

Based upon Job Creation:

- The maximum amount of a CDBG-ED award is \$1 million.
- The maximum amount of a CDBG-PF-ED is \$500,000.
