Wisconsin eGovernment Program Recognized by National Association of State Chief Information Officers

Madison – Wisconsin’s eGovernment Program is a 2016 finalist in the “CIO Recognition Award” category of the State IT Recognition Awards from the National Association of State Chief Information Officers (NASCIO). The Awards honor outstanding information technology achievements in the public sector. The Wisconsin eGovernment Program was selected by the NASCIO Awards Committee from a field of more than 130 nominees.

Initiated in May 2013, this public/private partnership with Wisconsin Interactive Network, LLC (WIN) applies consistency to the proposal, evaluation, approval, and development of State IT projects. The Wisconsin eGovernment Program utilizes innovative funding models to gain cost and quality efficiencies and fosters communication and collaboration among state agencies. In three years, the Program has launched over 66 services for more than 11 million website and eGovernment service users.
