**Subject:** Miscellaneous Classification Plan Changes as a Result of **Professional Social Services (PSS) 2005-2007** Contract Bargaining

Pursuant to s. 230.09, Wis. Stats., the Director of the Office of State Employment Relations (OSER) has approved the classification plan changes identified in this bulletin. Regardless of the actual notification date, the **effective date is July 23, 2006** unless otherwise stated.

- 1) **Create** the classifications of **Cadet Specialist (A), Cadet Specialist (B), Cadet Specialist-Lead, and Cadet Specialist Supervisor, effective July 23, 2006**. As part of the 2005-2007 contract negotiations with the PSS Bargaining Unit, assign those classifications to the appropriate pay ranges. - 2) **Reassign the pay range, effective July 23, 2006**, for the classifications of **Chief Regional Psychologist, Corrections Program Specialist-Objective, Labor Market Analyst (A, B, C), Offender Class Specialist (A,B), Psychologist-Licensed, School Psychologist, School Psychologist-Senior, Social Worker, Social Worker-Advanced and Social Worker-Senior** due to completion of 2005-2007 contract negotiations with the PSS Bargaining Unit. 
