WASTE FACILITY SITING AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered pursuant to Wis. Stat. s. 144.445 by and between Aqua-Tech, Inc., the applicant for a license from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to construct and operate a small hazardous waste storage facility, and the Local Committee created by a resolution of the City of Port Washington.

Aqua-Tech, Inc., 140 South Park Street, City of Port Washington, Ozaukee County, Wisconsin ("the Company") has submitted an application to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources for a license to construct and operate a small storage area for hazardous wastes at 1275 South Port Drive ("the facility"). After due and timely notice from the Company, the City of Port Washington adopted a siting resolution, creating a "local committee" within the meaning of Wis. Stat. s. 144.445(3)(e).

After appropriate public notice, a meeting between the Local Committee and representatives of the Company was held at City Hall, Port Washington, Wisconsin, on October 8, 1987. These negotiations and discussions resulted in the following agreement:

AGREEMENT

1. Subject to the terms of this Agreement, the City of Port Washington agrees that the Company may proceed with obtaining state and federal regulatory approvals for the facility, and further, that the City of Port Washington does not object to the issuance by the Department of Natural Resources of a license for the facility.

2. The company has submitted building plans to the Planning Commission of the City of Port Washington for approval. The Company acknowledges and agrees that it is required to go through the Planning Commission approval process for the facility.
3. The Company agrees that it will observe and comply with all applicable state and federal statutes, administrative rules and regulations pertaining to the handling and transportation of hazardous waste at the Company's Port Washington facility.
4. The Company agrees that appropriate supervision of all loading and unloading activities will occur at its Port Washington facility.
5. Under Wis. Stat. s. 144.445(9)(i), this Agreement must be submitted to the Common Council of the City of Port Washington for approval within two weeks after this agreement is approved by the Company and the Local Committee. The elected officials on the Local Committee agree to submit this Agreement to the City Council for approval, and will use their best efforts to secure such approval from said Council.
