RE: REVISED - Volkswagen Transit Capital Assistance Grant Program (Program) – NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD

Dear Applicants:

On November 28, 2018 the Department of Administration (DOA), on behalf of the State of Wisconsin (State), published the Notice of Intent to Award for the Transit Capital Assistance Grant Program. Since publishing the Notice of Intent to Award DOA has learned that certian applicants proposed replacing buses that are ineligible under the terms of the Volkswagen Diesel Emissions Environmental Mitigation Trust Agreement for State Beneficiaries. Because the initial Award Recommendations were based on the total number of eligible buses proposed for replacement, DOA is required to revise the Award Recommendations based on the buses currently known to be eligible. Evaluator scores were not changed. DOA intends to issue grant awards to the following recipients for the purchase of transit buses and other eligible expenses:
