2. Water Utility Easements on the behalf of the Fox River Navigational System Authority (Appleton Lock #2, Old Oneida Road and Appleton Lock #3, E. Newberry Street) – Request authority to execute two permanent water utility easements from the Fox River Navigational System Authority to the City of Appleton for a total of \$2.00. The easements cover Appleton Lock #2, a 1,260 SF storm sewer easement and Appleton Lock #3, a 2,307 SF water main easement.

In April 2013, the SBC approved a water utility main perpetual easement at the FRNSA Kaukauna Lock #5 to Wisconsin Public Service for an initial \$500 administrative fee and then \$1,250 for the first five-year period commencing on the effective date of the agreement.
