The project is part of a project at the Army Aviation Support Facility, which was enumerated in 2009 Wisconsin Act 28 for an estimated cost of \$54,589,200 (\$600,000 Existing General Fund Supported Borrowing, \$4,429,100 General Fund Supported Borrowing, and \$49,560,100 Federal Funds).

 - b) Waiver of Wis. Stats s.16.855 under the provisions of s.13.48(19) to allow single prime bidding:
 - i) Require general contractors to identify as part of their bid, the name of sub-contractors as defined by DSF in the bid packages;
 - ii) Include administrative safeguards in the contracts so that major sub-contractors on these single-prime contracts are paid in a timely manner; and
 - c) Increase the project scope and budget by \$622,000 (\$250,000 Grant Funds and \$372,000 Existing General Fund Supported Borrowing; and

9. UW-Madison – Request the following:
- a) Approval of the Design Report for Phase I of the Student Athlete Performance Center project; and
 - b) Authority to construct Phase I of the project at a cost of \$17,870,000 Program Revenue Supported Borrowing, as a portion of the total estimated project cost of \$76,800,000 (\$49,200,000 Program Revenue Supported Borrowing and \$27,600,000 Gift Funds).

The project was enumerated at \$76,800,000 (\$49,200,000 Program Revenue Supported Borrowing and \$27,600,000 Gift Funds) in 2011 Wisconsin Act 32.

In June 2011, the Building Commission granted authority, contingent upon enumeration, to allow selection, through a Request for Proposal process, of a Construction-Manager-at Risk (CMAR) for construction of the UW Athletics Badger Performance Center at a preliminary estimated budget of \$76,800,000 (\$49,200,000 Program Revenue Supported Borrowing and \$27,600,000 Gifts) in which all of the work shall be publically bid at the direction of the Division of State Facilities.

11. UW-River Falls – Request, in association with projects to improve Cascade Avenue and expand a parking lot, authority to:

- a) Convey 1.567 acres of Board or Regents-owned land for use as right-of-way in exchange for the receipt from the city of River Falls 2.013 acres of land, which is currently used as a right-of-way;
- b) Reimburse the city of River Falls for assessable improvements valued at \$1,729,706 using \$607,369 2011-13 General Fund Supported Borrowing, \$309,375 2009-11 General Fund Supported Borrowing and \$253,125 Residual Funds from a utility project, and \$559,837 Program Revenue – Cash; and
