## U.S. Census Bureau Urban Area Definition

- Absolute minimum - at least 5,000 people or 2,000 housing units.
- Nucleus - at least one block with I,275 housing units per square mile.
- Urban core - blocks near nucleus with 425 housing units / sq. mi.
- Urban area - blocks near core with 200 housing units / sq. mi.
- Binary - each census block is either "urban" or "rural".
- "near" - I.5 miles or less (intervening blocks not included)
