Requests for Purchasing Authority (RPAs) &



The Enterprise Section reviews all general waivers, sole source waivers, vehicle waivers, and collective purchases that are NOT Information Technology (IT) or legal services.





We review the provided documentation, ask clarifying questions, ensure the portal is filled out accurately, and draft the case letter.





Each RPA is reviewed by a Procurement Specialist and by the Enterprise Section Chief.
