




Kickoff **STAR Benefits Realization Program**, and project charter outlining the categories that will be targeted in phases of sourcing activity

Procedures will be established for agencies to more easily request consulting assistance from Enterprise IT Sourcing staff on complex IT contracts, negotiations



One Procurement **SharePoint site** will be established to post procurement plans, establish discussion forums, and track group projects

State Procurement Manual reform project underway with IPC agencies

Current agreements for delegated agencies will be improved to clarify roles, incorporate the One Procurement model, and any legal carve-outs (as applicable)

CAPS agencies will be engaged in a review of official sub-delegation agreements for being a CAPS-member agency

We will **improve the piggybacking process** to make it easier for agencies to leverage other agency contracts





SBOP will explore an enterprise license/contract for an **electronic signature solution**



Agencies impacted by STAR will begin revisiting requirements for a **supplier contract management solution** and share with STAR to determine the best enterprise approach to automate contract management (Phase 1)



Charter the **pilot Vendor Management Program with DET** for improved IT supplier management

Enhance VendorNet to make IT contract resources easier to find and use

Create an **IT Edition** of the existing Procurement Desk Guide
