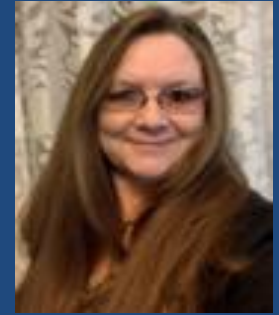

DocuSign

- Enterprise usage continues to grow.
- Continued commitment to having a DocuSign contract going forward.
- Contract continues:
 - **User experience-** Practically unlimited envelopes.
 - **Behind the scenes:**
 - SBOP estimates the next year's envelope usage and contracts with DocuSign to get the best rate per envelope.
 - If actual usage exceeds the estimate, then we purchase additional envelopes at the existing price (instead of getting the larger discount that would have been available if we purchased a larger envelope count up front.
 - **Billing:** Still billed as part of your agency's Ch. 16 procurement assessment.

 - Not through VendorNet

VendorNet

- VendorNet is getting an overhaul!
 - The backend of VendorNet is being replaced with much needed improvements to the current system.
 - **What to expect:**
 - Better, quicker, and more intuitive search functions.
 - Ability to have Agency/Campus-level administrators who can manage their own users, in addition to the WisPro admins.
 - Users will login with MyWisconsin ID credentials.
 - Updated appearance (no more giant wall of text on the homepage).
 - Better site functionality overall.
 - Updated backend, meaning a better experience for VendorNet admins.
 - **Timeline:** Construction is underway! Estimated launch early 2026.

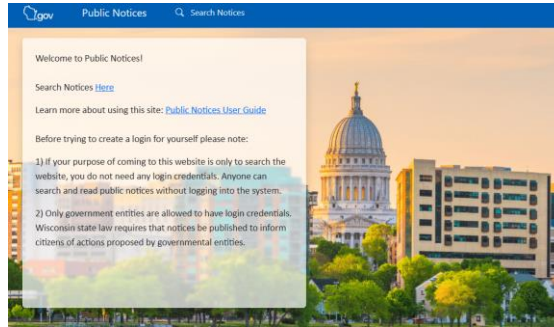

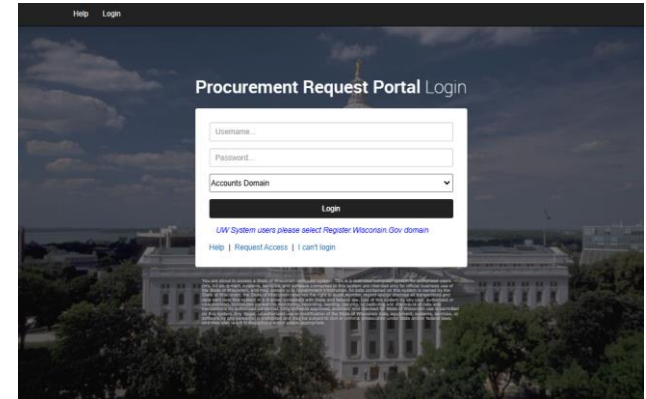
