Proclamation

WHEREAS; the Great Lakes are a vital resource connecting our state to the nation and the world, and have a profound impact on the economy and quality of life of the state and its harbor towns; and

WHEREAS; the State of Wisconsin recognizes the need to support sustainable economic development in order to enhance ecological, historical, cultural, and recreational opportunities along Lake Michigan's and Lake Superior's coasts; and

WHEREAS; the Wisconsin Coastal Management Program in the Department of Administration, a national leader for 35 years, was the first program on the Great Lakes and among the first ten nationally established through the Coastal Zone Management Act; and

WHEREAS; the partnership between the Wisconsin Coastal Management Program, Wisconsin Coastal Management Council, and the state's harbor towns and coastal communities exemplifies the state's commitment to this unique region; and

WHEREAS; to become better stewards of Wisconsin's coastal resources it is important to promote and encourage access to the Great Lakes for all of the state's residents;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,

COASTAL AWARENESS MONTH


throughout the State of Wisconsin, and I commend this observance to all of our citizens.
