II. <u>Technical College System Board</u>

Moved by Senator Johnson and seconded by Senator Roys to transfer \$3,500,000 GPR in fiscal year 2025-26 from the committee's supplemental appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(a) to the board's appropriation for grants to district boards under s. 20.292(1)(f) and \$3,500,000 GPR in fiscal year 2026-27 from the committee's supplemental appropriation to the board's appropriation for emergency medical services education under s. 20.292(1)(b).
