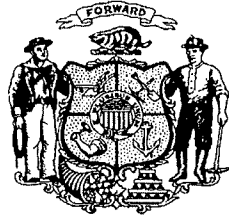

I. Department of Justice – Joshua Kaul, Attorney General

State of California, et al. v. U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, et al.,
No. 25-cv-12118-TI (D. Mass.)

II. Department of Transportation – Kristina Boardman, Secretary

The Department of Transportation requests a supplement of \$2,600,000 GPR in fiscal year 2025-26 from the committee's appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(a) to the department's public protective services hearing protection program appropriation under s. 20.395(5)(db) for the establishment of a public protective services hearing protection program pursuant to 2025 Wisconsin Act 14, 2025 Wisconsin Act 15, and 2025 Wisconsin Act 181.

III. Department of Public Instruction – Thomas McCarthy, Deputy State Superintendent

The Department of Public Instruction requests a supplement of \$500,000 GPR in fiscal year 2026-27 from the committee's appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(a) to the department's professional development for science teachers appropriation under s. 20.255(1)(eb) to support the department's development of a program to provide professional development opportunities to science teachers and provide science equipment to teachers participating in such opportunities for use at school.

IV. Higher Educational Aids Board – Tammie DeVooght-Blaney, Executive Director

The Higher Educational Aids Board requests a supplement of \$3,400,000 GPR in fiscal year 2026-27 from the committee's appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(a) to the board's emergency medical services training reimbursement appropriation under s. 20.235(1)(fa), to reimburse training and material expenses incurred by students completing an emergency medical services training course at a technical college. The board also requests a supplement of \$100,000 GPR in fiscal year 2026-27 from the committee's appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(a) to the board's general program operations appropriation under s. 20.235(2)(aa) to support information technology costs related to the new emergency medical services reimbursement program.

V. Department of Military Affairs – Major General Matthew J. Strub, Adjutant General

The Department of Military Affairs requests a supplement of \$6,121,100 SEG in fiscal year 2025-26 and \$7,000,000 SEG in fiscal year 2026-27 from the committee's appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(u) to the department's state disaster assistance; local government fund appropriation under s. 20.465(3)(sm) to pay claims submitted by local units of government for damages and costs incurred as a result of natural disasters.

VI. Department of Military Affairs – Major General Matthew J. Strub, Adjutant General

The Department of Military Affairs requests the creation of a 1.0 FTE SEG position in the department's Next Generation 911 appropriation under s. 20.465(3)(qm) to serve as the grant program lead for the Next Generation 911 program and a 1.0 FTE GPR position in the department's general program operations appropriation under s. 20.465(3)(a) to support the Wisconsin Interoperable System for Communications (WISCOM) program. To offset the position increases, the department also requests the deletion of 2.0 FTE FED positions in the department's federal aid, state operations appropriation under s. 20.465(3)(m). The position changes are requested to begin in fiscal year 2025-26.

VII. Department of Military Affairs – Major General Matthew J. Strub, Adjutant General

The Department of Military Affairs requests a supplement of \$100,000 SEG in fiscal year 2026-27 from the committee's appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(u) to the department's Live 911 appropriation under s. 20.465(3)(qp) for a pilot grant program for Live 911 to enable real-time video and multimedia communications between public safety answering points and individuals who call for emergency services.

VIII. Department of Military Affairs – Major General Matthew J. Strub, Adjutant General

The Department of Military Affairs requests the transfer of \$33,500 GPR from fiscal year 2025-26 to fiscal year 2026-27 in the department's general program operations appropriation under s. 20.465(3)(a) related to the State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program in order to align administrative funding with when federal grants are anticipated to be expended.

IX. Department of Natural Resources – Karen Hyun, Secretary

The Department of Natural Resources requests a supplement of \$2,880,700 SEG in fiscal year 2026-27 from the committee's appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(u) to the department's general program operations – state funds appropriation under s. 20.370(1)(mu) to conduct core work in the Bureau of Fisheries Management.

X. Department of Natural Resources – Karen Hyun, Secretary

The Department of Natural Resources requests a supplement of \$1,141,500 SEG in fiscal year 2026-27 from the committee's appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(u) to the department's general program operations – state funds appropriation under s. 20.370(1)(mu) to conduct core work in the Bureau of Wildlife Management.
