The Department of Justice requests a supplement of \$4,000,000 GPR in fiscal year 2025-26 from the committee's appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(a) to the department's law enforcement data sharing appropriation under s. 20.455(2)(db) to award grants to law enforcement agencies under the grants for data-sharing platforms for law enforcement program created by 2025 Wisconsin Act 58.

The Department of Employee Trust Funds requests a supplement of \$632,600 SEG and 6.0 FTE SEG four-year project positions in fiscal year 2026-27 on an ongoing basis from the committee's appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(u) to the department's administration appropriation under s. 20.515(1)(w) to address operational needs required to administer state and local government employee benefit programs, as the department shifts existing resources to support the implementation of a new pension administration information technology system.

IV. Department of Administration – Kathy Blumenfeld, Secretary

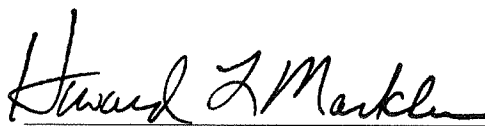
The Department of Administration requests approval for the sale of two buildings and 2.529 acres in Madison to GEF Development LLC. The State Building Commission approved this sale at its August 12, 2026, meeting and the department submitted the sale for committee approval under s. 16.848(1).

V. Department of Natural Resources – Karen Hyun, Secretary

The Department of Natural Resources requests a supplement of \$9,999,900 SEG in fiscal year 2026-27 from the committee's appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(u) to the department's general program operations – PFAS appropriation under s. 20.370(1)(mw) to conduct environmental repair in response to per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS).

VI. Department of Transportation – Kristina Boardman, Secretary

The Department of Transportation requests a supplement of \$23,526,200 SEG in fiscal year 2026-27 from the committee's appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(u) on a one-time basis to the department's routine maintenance activities, state funds appropriation under s. 20.395(3)(es) to cover a projected deficit in the appropriation related to elevated winter weather costs incurred during the 2025-26 winter season.
