Minutes of the Meeting under s. 13.10

November 4, 2015

Co-Chair Nygren presided and called the meeting to order.

Present: Senators Darling, Olsen, Harsdorf, Vukmir, Tiffany, Marklein, L. Taylor, Erpenbach Representatives Nygren, Kooyenga, Loudenbeck, Knudson, Schraa, Czaja, C. Taylor, Hintz

I. <u>Department of Justice</u>

Moved by Senator Darling and seconded by Representative Kooyenga to: (a) transfer \$146,800 GPR in 2015-16 and \$220,000 GPR in 2016-17, from the Committee's appropriation under s. 20.865(4)(a) to the Department of Justice's legal services general program operations appropriation under s. 20.455(1)(a); and (b) create 2.0 FTE GPR assistant attorney general positions in the appropriation under s. 20.455(1)(a) beginning in 2015-16, to assist the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office with the investigation and prosecution of firearm-related criminal offenses in the city of Milwaukee.

II. Department of Transportation

Moved by Representative Nygren and seconded by Representative Loudenbeck to approve the Department of Transportation's use of \$350,000,000 in general obligation bond proceeds, as provided for under section 9145(1v) of 2015 Wisconsin Act 55. Provide that debt service on the first \$175,000,000 in bonds be paid from the general fund and that debt service on the second \$175,000,000 in bonds be paid from the transportation fund. Specify that \$200,000,000 is approved for use in 2015-16 and that \$150,000,000 is approved for use in 2016-17. Provide that the \$150,000,000 approved for use in 2016-17 must be reduced by the amount, if any, by which the total state revenues for the transportation fund as shown in the annual fiscal report for fiscal year 2015-16 exceed \$1,661,562,400, subject to a maximum reduction of \$150,000,000. Specify that the department must use the \$350,000,000 in bond proceeds as follows: (a) \$75,000,000 annually in 2015-17 for the state highway rehabilitation program; and (b) \$125,000,000 in 2015-16 and \$75,000,000 in 2016-17 for the major highway development program. Specify that if the amount approved for use in 2016-17 is reduced due

to additional revenue in 2015-16, the reduction shall first be made from the \$75,000,000 allocated to the major highway development program, with any additional reduction being made from \$75,000,000 allocated to the state highway rehabilitation program. Increase estimated debt service payments in 2016-17 by \$12,537,000 GPR and \$1,791,000 SEG.
