- Benefits:
 - Legal review of terms and conditions
 - Consistency in wording, structure
 - Provides uniformity across agencies
 - Allows for easier review for bidders

- Using required systems (eSupplier/Strategic Sourcing or VendorNet), post the solicitation with all
- · Posting on systems will post to Public Notices site
- Solicit written questions from bidders, post answers
- · Where necessary, post amendments to the solicitation in writing, notify bidders

· On-site visit with potential bidders

Issue & Manage Bid

 Bidder conference for purpose of answering questions, enforcing instruction on bid submittal

Develop Bid Package

- Using the RFB template as a start, create specifications and special terms and conditions
- · Develop market-appropriate cost/price sheet
- · Generate potential bidders lists and conduct preliminary outreach
- · Create "shell" of bid file to fill over time

Optional:

- · Request for Information
- · Post draft bid for vendor comment

If the bid is for services over \$50,000:

- · Complete CBA (some exceptions apply)
- Ensure protest/appeals language is included in the bid
- Include American Services requirements (some exceptions apply)

New in 2018: School Safety Contracts Website








Happy Anniversary, STAR Strategic Sourcing!





State Procurement Manual Home

The Department of Administration, through the State Bureau of Procurement, purchases commodities and services for the state through direct or delegated authority and establishes policy and procedures for the performance of this function under the governance of Ch. 16, Wis. Stats.

The State Procurement Manual is the official publication for disseminating policy and procedures on the state's procurement function. The Manual is your guide to statewide policies and procedures for obtaining materials, supplies, equipment, contractual services and all other items of a consumable nature.

The State Bureau of Procurement issues the Manual and updates it as necessary. Announcements of updates are communicated to agency purchasing directors or the established contact in the Directory of State Bureaus of Procurement/Transportation and State Agency Purchasing/Printing Offices. This agency contact person is responsible for distributing information within his/her agency.

Agencies with delegated purchasing authority are responsible for keeping up to date on all additions, revisions or deletions published by the State Bureau of Procurement.
