



New to eSupplier:


- View pre-announcements of upcoming agency bid opportunities




Strategic Sourcing Naming Conventions - Templates, Library Items and Bid Factors

Automated RPA System

Real-time feedback

Users and approvers can track an RPA's approval process in real-time

Increased functionality

Approvers will be able to send the RPA back to a previous step or to the submitting agency if more information is needed

Improved data collection

Users and approvers can access charts and graphs to compare the amount of time an RPA spends in each approval stage


Automated RPA System

Improved consistency


Required information and attachments are clearly noted and users must complete all required sections before submitting an RPA for approval


Professional Development in Software Licensing

- SBOP will also focus support of IT and telecommunications procurement activities across the enterprise.





SBOP will be publishing workable templates to VendorNet, with separate user guides on how to complete each one.









Agencies Increasing On-Contract Spend!

Since the State implemented a business intelligence solution to track certain spend metrics through the STAR ERP system, we have seen marked improvement in state agency on-contract spend.














- New suppliers added: 16

- Growth in daily transactions: 44%










Agency with the largest increase in WISBuy users: DNR


• Top vendor by spend: Staples

• Top vendor by number of transactions: Staples


 Most opportunity for growth: Computer Equipment & Related Services




What percentage of our spend is completed through WISBuy?





Federal Surplus Property Program


Tight Budget? Looking to save money for your organization?




SBOP Outreach


