### WISCONSIN SUPPLIER DIVERSITY PROGRAM FY22 SUCCESSES

### 1. Total Diverse Supplier Spend:

- 1. Diverse suppliers accounted for \$206,084,063 of a \$3,485,034,478 total spend.
- 2. Represents 5.91% of the total spend.

#### 2. State Agency General Procurement:

- 1. State agencies spent \$156,600,107 with MBE/DVB businesses.
- 2. Achieved 6.26% of the total spend.

### 3. Architectural/Engineering Services:

- 1. DFD spent \$81,551,445 on architectural/engineering services.
- 2. Certified MBE firms accounted for \$5,447,341, representing 7.17% of total spend.

### 4. State Highway Program:

- 1. DOT's State Highway Program expended \$29,071,227 with MBEs.
- 2. Met the goal with 5.89% of total spend.

We certify MBEs, DVBs, and WBEs, enhancing their opportunities to work with the State of WI, government agencies, and private companies.

- May I bid on State projects before being certified?
- ■You do not need to be certified to bid on State projects; however, you must be certified to utilize the MBE or DVB 5% bid preference.
