Department of Administration Announces \$2.4 Million in HOME Rental Housing Development Funds

The Department of Administration (DOA) announces that it will be awarding \$2.4 million in HOME Rental Housing Development Funds. These funds will impact communities across Wisconsin by providing affordable low-income housing for individuals.

"These funds will provide essential resources for communities across Wisconsin to provide affordable housing for its citizens," said DOA Secretary Mike Huebsch. "It is important that all Wisconsin citizens have access to safe and affordable housing."

DOA's Division of Housing awards these HOME Rental Housing funds through a competitive process. Applications are accepted year-round for these grants. Four applications were from Community Housing Development Organizations. These are non-profit entities with a proven capacity in delivering affordable housing for low income households.
