Department of Administration Announces \$500,000 Grant to Replace Seawall and Water Main in Two Rivers

The Department of Administration (DOA) announces that it is awarding a \$500,000 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Public Facility grant to the City of Two Rivers. This grant will help the City of Two Rivers replace a failing harbor seawall, as well as a 105 year old water main.

"This grant will help the City of Two Rivers replace crucial parts of their community's infrastructure in a timely matter to ensure no further damage is done to the seawall and water main," said DOA Secretary Mike Huebsch.

The project will rebuild 400 feet of seawall and replace 700 feet of damaged water main. Various sections of the seawall have breached in recent years, causing erosion of the seawall structure. The urgent need to repair this infrastructure qualified for the "Urgent Local Need" category of CDBG grants. Funding for these awards comes from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

The total project is estimated to cost nearly \$2 million and is scheduled to begin in early 2014.
