Department of Administration Announces a \$200,000 Grant to Construct a New Sewer Lift Station in the Town of Fifield

The Department of Administration (DOA) announces that it is awarding a \$202,850 Community Development Block Grant to the Town of Fifield. The funds will be used to replace an aging and deteriorating sewerage lift station within the sanitary district.

"This grant will make it possible for the Town of Fifield to move forward with a project that is critical to its infrastructure," said DOA Secretary Mike Huebsch. "These types of grants help support and improve our communities, which creates a better Wisconsin for our citizens."

A sewer lift station allows for the continuous flow of wastewater where gravity sewers are ineffective or too expensive to build. Because the current system has become antiquated and repair and replacement has become more problematic, the Department of Administration approved the grant under its "urgent need" category of CDBG grants for public infrastructure.

The total project is estimated to cost more than \$405,000. The Town of Fifield will begin the project later this month, which is estimated to finish in July.
