Governor Walker's Budget Makes Historic Investments in Wisconsin's Future

Madison - Today, Department of Administration Secretary Scott Neitzel appeared before the Joint Committee on Finance to discuss Governor Walker's 2017-19 Biennial Budget. Secretary Neitzel issued the following statement:
