Centennial Celebration Scavenger Hunt September 30

Capitol Virtual Tour Receives Creative Award

Madison – The State Capitol Tours program in conjunction with the Centennial Celebration will be hosting a scavenger hunt at the State Capitol on Saturday, September 30, 2017 from 1 PM to 3 PM. The event is open to kids who are able to read and write.

Participants can pick up the scavenger list on the first-floor rotunda table set up by Capitol Tours. Items on the list will be located throughout the first-floor rotunda, ground floor rotunda, and outside on the Capitol grounds.

The scavenger hunt is a part of a year-long series of events to celebrate the Capitol's 100th anniversary. Earlier this year, the Department of Administration launched a new <u>Capitol Virtual Tour</u> to commemorate the building. We are pleased to announce that out of more than 5,000 submissions from 24 countries, the Wisconsin State Capitol Virtual Tour was named a 2017 Gold Summit Creative Award winner. The Virtual Tour was nominated for its innovative use of mobile virtual technology to showcase the Wisconsin State Capitol.

At <u>Capitol.Wisconsin.Gov</u>, visitors can explore areas of the Capitol building via a modern web browser, mobile device, or a virtual reality headset. Select Points of Interest in nine different capitol building locations provide details about key elements of artistic, architectural, or historic interest. The Wisconsin Capitol Virtual Tour was delivered at through a public-private partnership between the State of Wisconsin and Wisconsin Interactive Network, LLC.
