AGENCY DESCRIPTION

The board is required by s. 146.59, Wisconsin Statutes, to negotiate and enter into a contractual services agreement with the University of Wisconsin Hospitals and Clinics Authority. This agreement between the board and authority covers the provision of nonprofessional services to the authority by the represented employees of the board.

The membership of the board includes thirteen voting and two nonvoting members designated as follows: three members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate, for three-year terms; each co-chairperson of the Joint Committee on Finance or a member of the committee designated by that co-chairperson; three members of the Board of Regents appointed by the president of the Board of Regents; the chancellor of the University of Wisconsin-Madison or his/her designee; the dean of the University of Wisconsin-Madison Medical School, appointed by the chancellor of the University of Wisconsin-Madison; a faculty member of a University of Wisconsin health professions school, other than the University of Wisconsin-Madison Medical School, appointed by the chancellor of the University of Wisconsin-Madison; the secretary of the Department of Administration or his/her designee; and two nonvoting members appointed by the Governor, one representing the professional represented employees and one representing the nonprofessional represented employees.
