Upon the Governor's death, resignation or removal from office, the Lieutenant Governor shall become Governor for the balance of the unexpired term. The Lieutenant Governor may be designated by the Governor as his or her representative on any statutory commission, board or committee on which the Governor is entitled to membership. Under such designated by law to the Governor with regard to such membership.

The Lieutenant Governor may serve as the Governor's designated representative on any nonstatutory committee or on any intergovernmental body created for the purpose of maintaining relationships with the federal government, state governments, regional agencies or local governments. The Governor may designate the Lieutenant Governor to coordinate state services and programs.
