FY 2016 Period 12 Closes on Friday, September 2nd

Period 12 will close for all agencies on Friday, September 2nd. It will only be reopened in extreme situations where a large number of correcting transactions must be processed through a subsystem in FY 2016, (i.e. Funds Distribution). STAR and the SCO are making every effort to complete all remaining closing work, and respond to all open tickets prior to the Friday cut-off. Any remaining adjustments for FY 2016 will need to be made in FY 2016 Period 996, with SCO approval.

Agencies must make their final Form 78 verifications no later than Tuesday, September 6th (after Friday's transactions have been incorporated). On Wednesday, September 7th, agencies will be provided with an inventory of their appropriations, and will need to indicate the issue/JIRA ticket that is preventing them from verifying any of their appropriations.

Period 993 will continue to be used for Commitment Control adjustments as required.
